This sterotypes was propagated to de sexualize and frame the mobility and freedom of Blackwomen into certain limits. The past movements feed then abortion and contraception as Black genocide myth. The Black Panthers, the Pan-African Movement, and some in the Civil Rights movement all aligned hemselves with anti-choice rhetoric aimed at Black-women and their reproductive capabilities.
