1. Explain why myths and misconceptions about abortions are dangerous.

Misinformation of any sort is dangerous. It leads to unsafe practices and possible fatal outcome. Because of these myths and misconceptions, abortion seekers are not aware of their rights and are often misled to believe the said service is illegal.

2. Most of the myths and misconceptions about abortion are based on which concerns?

Most of these myths and misconceptions are centred around the repercussions and consequences of the procedure. These are often influenced by religious practices and societal norms.

3. Which misconception about abortion can cause serious physical harm?

Insertion of sharp object to terminate the pregnancy can cause serious physical harm like uterine rupture, infection or even death.

4. Under what circumstances can abortion cause infertility?

Safe abortions do not affect fertility. If abortion is performed by an unqualified practitioner or performed unsafely, it can lead to infection and thereby affect fertility.

5. What are the causes of stress and trauma for people seeking abortions and how can stress and trauma be minimised?

Abortion can cause long-term mental health issue if comprehensive abortion care is not in place. But most of the stress and trauma is because of the stigma around abortion.
